

Monday, July 24, 2017 – Deliberations #2

At this meeting, the Council nearly disclosed their support or opposition on housing on the Baylands, demonstrating their collective eagerness to make a decision. The City's attorney, however, reminded the Council that per State law the public must be informed of the Council's agenda 72 hours in advance, and they should instead follow the published agenda and meeting matters. The Council proceeded to review their extensive list of questions that dealt with various important issues related to the site, including transit and remediation.

The Council concluded a series public hearings for their review of the Brisbane Baylands Specific Plan Application and EIR in June, and transitioned into deliberations. There are only three Council meetings left. Please join us Monday, August 7th and Thursday August 17th. Meetings start 7:30pm at City Hall, 50 Park Place. Ask the Council to support of much-needed housing and commercial uses on the Baylands site. Reach out to the decision-makers and have your voice heard!
